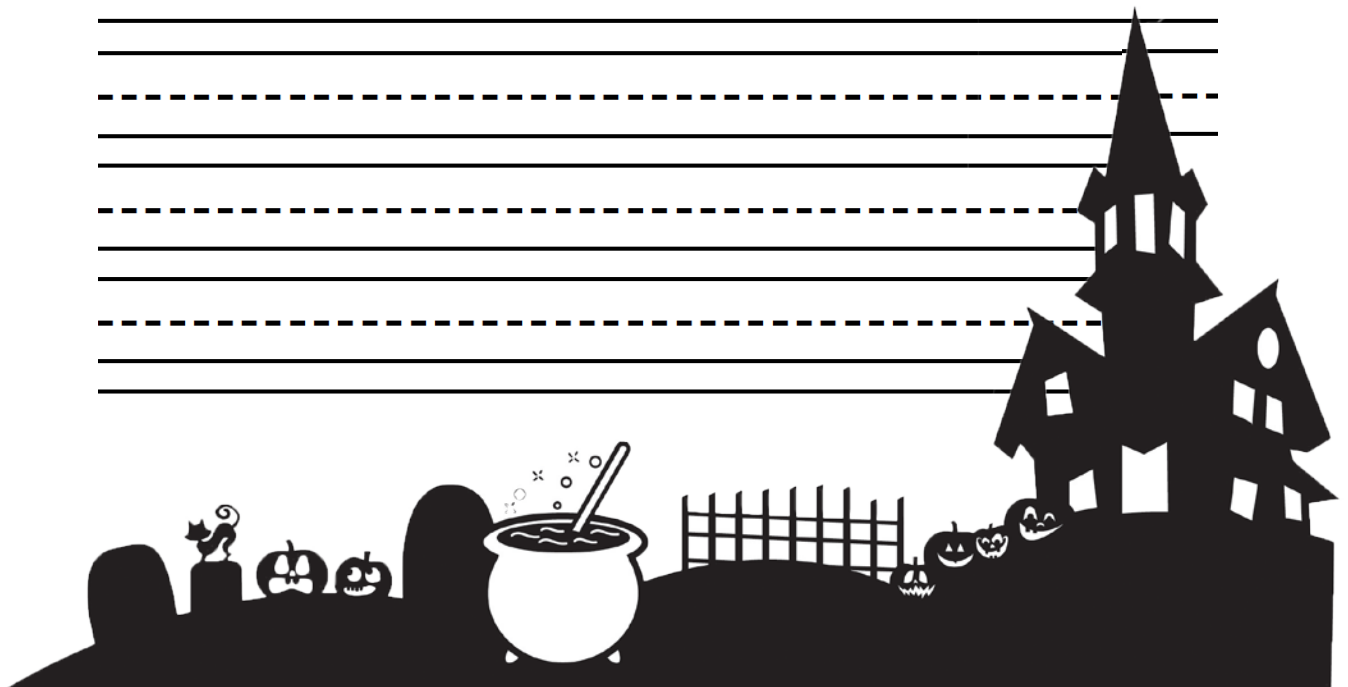

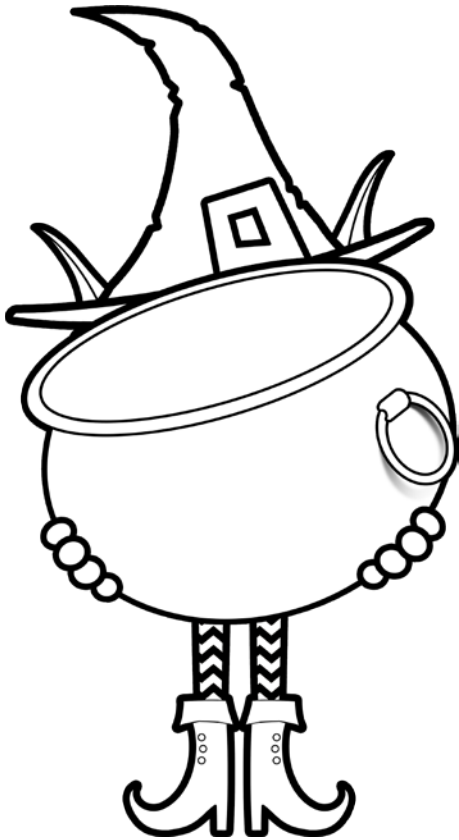
# Monster Portrait
